Purpose of the Study:

A link to the survey platform Google Forms will be provided for you to register. This will help me discover the best time to schedule the focus groups. Additionally, some demographic information will help me interpret the results.

After completion of the survey, I will schedule you to then participate in one 60-75 minute online focus group. There will be a link to a WebEx video conferencing provided to you. You will also be provided instructions on how to log in. You and several other DSPs from other parts of the country will be asked questions about behavioral support needs in general, data collection practices with mobile technology, and how the data used in client care. Once the WebEx recording is transcribed, the video recording will be deleted.

Risks or Discomforts, and Benefits of Being in the Study:

The study has minimal risks, and you will only be asked to respond to what you are comfortable with answering. Your information will remain confidential. To further preserve confidentiality, if you are using a client example, please don't provide any identifying information.

The benefits to participation are you be contributing to limited research that includes the DSP perspective on the utilization of mobile technology for behavioral support needs. The researchers' intention is to include your voice and expertise on the topic.

Confidentiality and Anonymity:

Records will be kept private and will be handled in a confidential manner to the extent provided by law. In any report or presentation, the researcher will not include any information that will make it possible to identify you as research study participant. You will remain anonymous. For example, in the report you will be referred to as "Participant #1" or "P1". Once in the group please respect the privacy of other participants by not taking screenshots or video capture of the session.

Voluntary Participation:

Your participation is voluntary, refusal to participate will involve no penalty or loss of benefits to which you are otherwise entitled, and you may discontinue participation at any time without penalty or loss of benefits to which you are otherwise entitled.
